FREESTYLE TERRAIN

Look before you leap.
 Freestyle terrain use, like all skiing and riding, exposes you to the risk of serious injury. Prior to using freestyle terrain, it is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with the terrain and obey all instructions, warnings and signs. Freestyle skills require maintaining control on the ground and in the air.

Easy style it.
 Start small and work your way up. Designations are relative to this ski area.

Respect gets respect.
 Freestyle terrain has designations for size: **SMALL MEDIUM LARGE**. Start small and work your way up. Designations are relative to this ski area.

PROGRESSION PARK, on Painted Horse trail, located on Saddleback Peak. Check out this park designed for learning new tricks on elements designed for those new to the terrain park scene. This terrain park is designated as **SMALL**.

TERRAIN PARK, located on Sun Peak and on Upper and Lower Respect trails. The Canyons' signature terrain park geared towards advanced skiers and riders. This terrain park is designated as **MEDIUM and LARGE**.
